

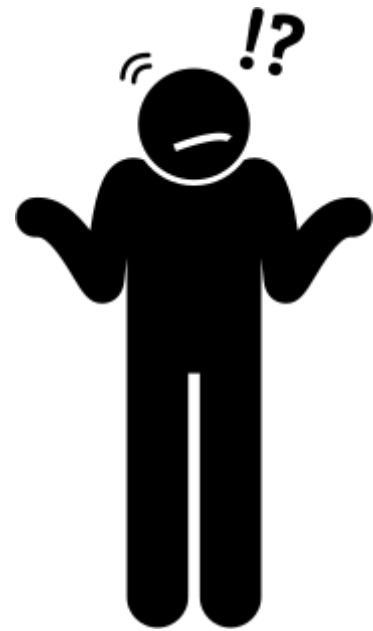

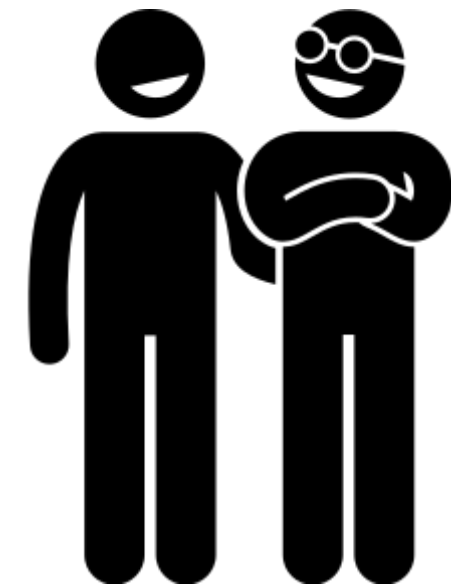

# Community Link Capital Region

- Information

# HandsOn Sacramento



The Regional Center for Volunteerism-HandsOn Sacramento was created in 1998 in response to the community's need for a full-service volunteer action center.

- Serves the Sacramento region
- Connects individuals and groups to volunteer opportunities through an online matching system.
- Offers training to NPOs to provide more meaningful volunteer experiences, increase capacity, and meet community needs.
- Provides volunteer management services for large scale community events and corporate volunteer days.
- Coordinates annual "Days of Service" event.
- Serves as the Emergency Volunteer Center in times of disaster.

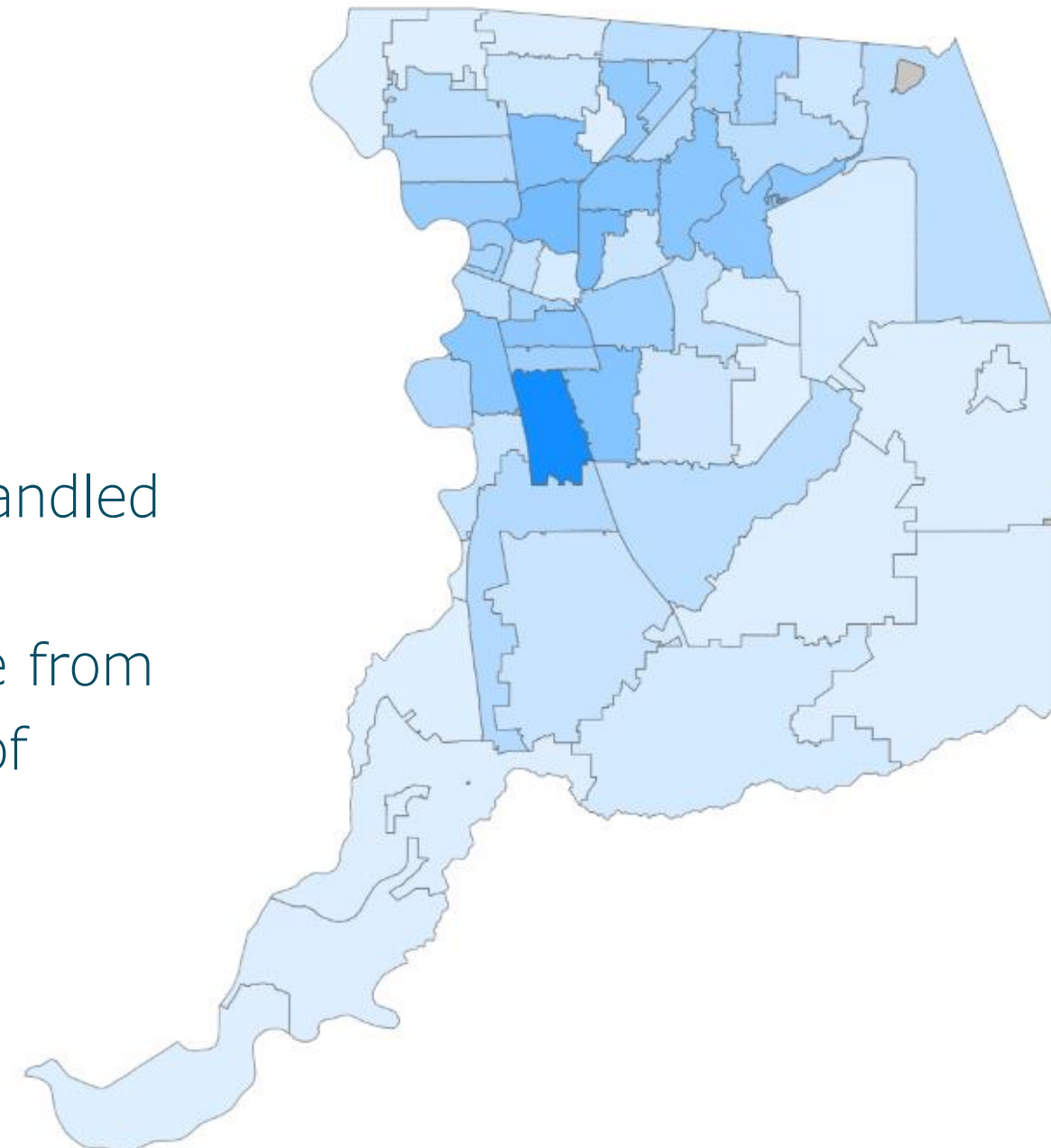

- 2,884,146 individuals directly served through projects in 2022



- 117,569 calls handled during 2022
- Most calls come from within the city of Sacramento

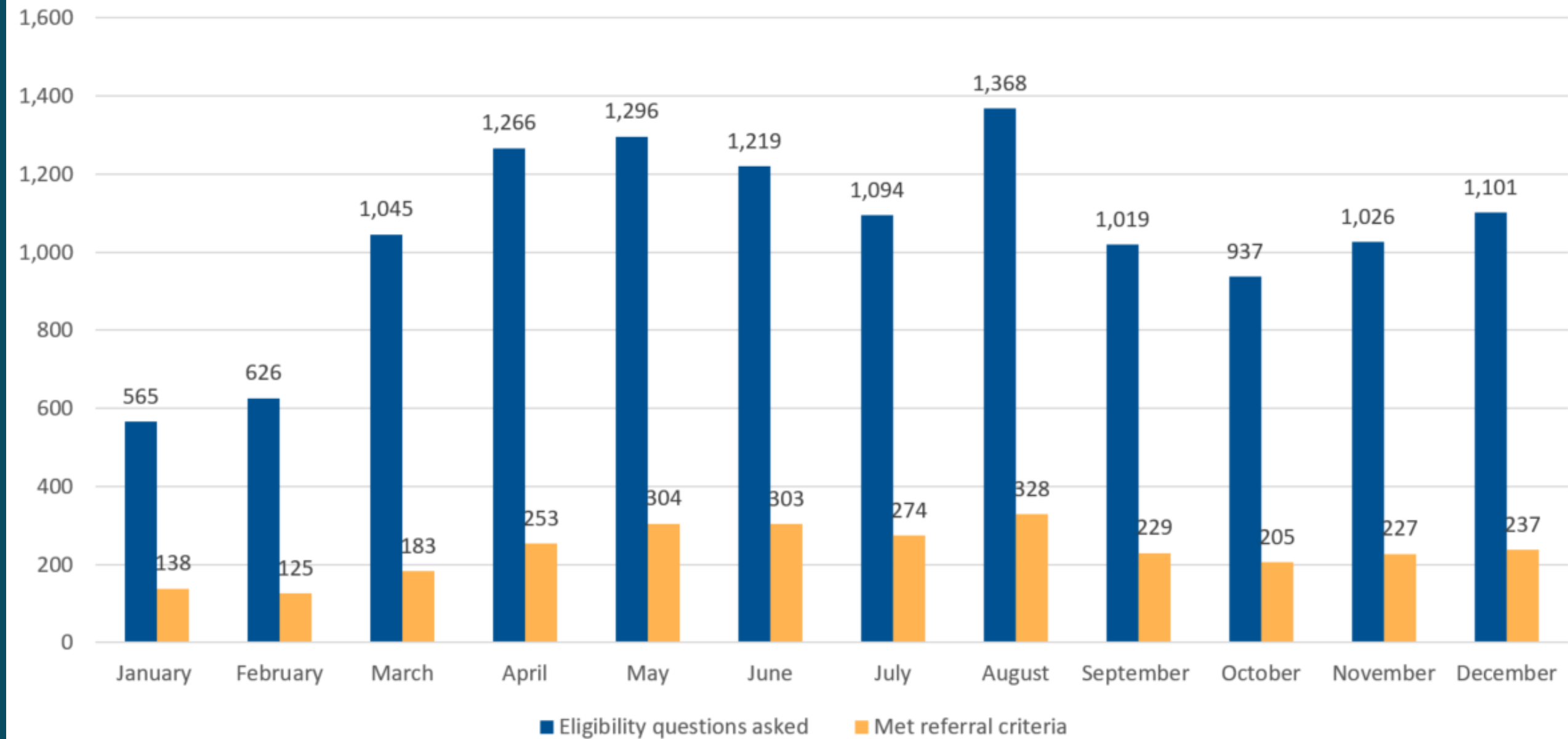
